Step 1: Gather your inputs

Gather 1, 2, or 3 moments, images, or sensory memories that feel connected or ask to be seen again.



Box 1: Your Memories

Write 2–4 sentences about the moments or setting.

Example: Standing at the edge of the granite shoreline in September while the tide pulled back. Sitting in the hospital waiting room watching snow fall on the parking lot. Lighting a candle on my quiet desk tonight.



Box 2: Your Returning Line (The Mirror)

Write 1 short phrase (3–6 words) that names what returns, repeats, or grounds you.

Example: We learn to keep our footing anyway

Step 2: Create your poem

Open your AI app (ChatGPT, Claude, or Canva Magic Write). Copy and paste the prompt below, replacing the brackets with your text from Box 1 and Box 2.



PROMPT TO COPY:

Turn my memories into a 14-line Recursive Mirror poem (4 stanzas: three 4-line quatrains and one final 2-line couplet) using these rules:

- Weave my memories from Box 1 into the stanzas.
- The Mirror Line: End line 9 or Line 13 with my exact phrase from Box 2.
- Final Couplet: Bring the memories into a grounded, lyrical resolution.

Keep my real words and sensory details. Make it steady, rhythmic, and honest. Do not add fake rhymes or forced filler words.
